


# Year 2 Spring - 2026

**English** - Our first book 'What Do You Do With a Tail Like This?' The children will be writing a page in the style of the book about animals of their choice.



Our second text we will be exploring a non-fiction text called 'This is how we do it'. The children will focus on their non-fiction writing skills to produce a piece of writing comparing their life to the life of someone in a different country.



**RE** - In this unit, children will explore what Christians believe is the "Good News" found in the Bible. They will learn that Christians understand Jesus' life and teachings as a message of love, hope, and guidance for the world. Through a range of stories and activities, children will discover how Jesus showed kindness, helped others, and taught people to live in a caring and thoughtful way.



**DT** - Textiles - The children will create their own pouches using simple sewing skills.



**Science** - children will learn about the methods scientists use to build scientific knowledge about the natural world. They will learn that scientists learn about plants by making careful observations and measurements, recording changes over time and carrying out enquiries to compare the effect of changing conditions. They will develop an understanding of the following types of enquiry: observing over time, pattern seeking, identifying and classifying, comparative testing.



**Geography** - The children will Identify and describe the location of where they live in the UK, within Europe and the world and in relation to the Equator and north and south poles. They will compare their own location with the location of Kampong Ayer. They will identify, describe and observe the types of traditional homes found in Kampong Ayer and compare and contrast these with their own homes and types of homes found in the locality of their school. They will Identify and describe the main elements which make up the weather and understand that weather conditions change from one moment to the next. They will recognise, describe and suggest reasons for the similarities and differences between school in Kampong Ayer and their own school.



**PSHE** - Citizenship the children will be learning about rules outside school; caring for the school and local environment; exploring the roles people have within the local community; learning how school council works; giving an opinion.



**Maths** - We will be using the Power Maths scheme of work to teach the children about addition and subtraction, across two units.



**Computing** - In this unit, children will learn how to design and build an interactive quiz using **Scratch**, a block-based programming tool. Pupils will explore how computers can be used to present questions, check answers, give feedback, and keep score.

**PE** - will be every Tuesday and every other Thursday. Please can you ensure your child wears a PE Kit to school on those days. This half term the children will be taking part in a dance unit and they will improve their understanding of game skills.

**Music** - The children will be taking part in weekly music sessions. The children will be learning about Myths and legends.

**Spelling** s - Will be every Thursday. The children will be given 5 words each week

**Read Write Inc** - The children will continue to have daily RWI lessons in school. The children will take home an AR/colour banded book as well as RWI book bag book to support their reading from home.
