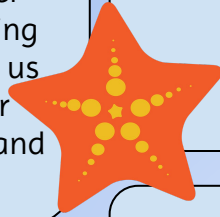


### Physical Development

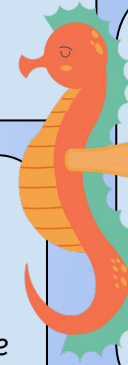
### Our Learning Journey Autumn 2

We will be expanding our vocabulary whilst we talk about the seasons in our natural world. We will ask questions and discuss when and how things grow.

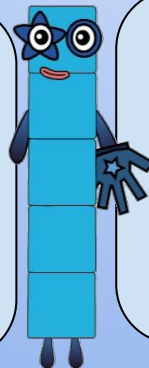
