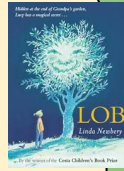


Year 3 - Summer 1

English

In English, we will read the text Lob to engage children with a story told through a mixture of voices and visual imagery. We will also explore, interpret and respond to illustrations in a book. Children will compose writing for a variety of purposes.



In reading, we will enjoy the book: The Iron Man with a focus on using inference skills. Daily reading and RWI lessons will continue as our progression through the RWI spelling programme.



Science

Children will carry out a range of different investigations involving plants. They will make predictions, carefully observe the results and draw their own conclusions. They will identify parts of flowering plants and explore how flowering plants grow.



Maths

We will also be learning about fractions - comparing and ordering unit fractions. We will also be exploring mass and capacity. Children will compare and order mass in grams and kilograms. We will explore capacity and volume in millilitres and litres.

History:

Children will learn about the Iron Age and how artefacts help us learn about this time period. They will find out about Hillforts - looking at their purpose and how they would have looked in the Iron Age. Children will use artefacts to conclude if conflict took place during the Iron Age.



PE, Music and French

In PE, children will be participating in athletics and learning skills involved in rounders.

In Music, the children are continuing to work on their ballads and will then begin to learn to play the recorder.

In French, the children will be focusing on French playground games - numbers and age.

RE and PSHE

Children will look at Economic wellbeing in PSHE and in RE we will explore how and why people celebrate significant events in their lives.

Computing

We will become expert animators in this unit as the children create stop-frame animations. They will also develop key teambuilding skills.

Art:

We will be exploring sculpture - using 2D shapes and bending, folding and slotting them together to create 3D sculptures. We will find out about Anthony Caro - a British artist who made abstract sculptures.
