

Year 4 - Summer 1

Science:

This half term, we will be learning all about sound. We will be identifying how sounds are made and that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear. We will find patterns between pitch and features of the sound source and volume and strength of vibrations.



Art and design:

We will be exploring tone, texture and proportion to create realistic and expressive drawings inspired by famous artists.



The children will also participate in creative and fun experiences during art week.

The children will be taught **French**, where they will explore numbers, calendars and birthdays.
