


## Literacy:

### CORE TEXT:

Zim Zam Zoom - we shall be performing and writing our own Kenning poems.

Weather- a non-fiction information text that we will use to write our own double page text



**Science** - We will be looking at animals, including humans and categorising animals in different ways. We will explore carnivore, herbivore and omnivore and look at the various groups of animals, including birds, reptiles, mammals, fish and amphibians.

### History- What does it take to be a great explorer?

The children will explore the concept of history and at their timeline, including when their parents were born. We will create a simple timeline to show their understanding of sequence of events. We will then look more closely at some of history's great explorers, such as; Neil Armstrong and Amy Johnson.

## Year 1 - Spring 1

### Maths: Power Maths scheme:

Children will be looking at understanding and working with numbers within 20. We will explore counting on from a number to solve addition problems and then use our knowledge of adding ones to help us solve problems and compare numbers up to 20.

**Art:** Children will be learning about how to mix colours and create prints with paint, replicating inspirational artists work.

**Computing: Creating media : digital writing** - We will be developing our understanding of computers becoming more familiar with keyboards and how to create text,

**RE** - Who do Christians believe made the world?



**RSHE-** What is the same and what is different about us?



**Handwriting:** The Children will be having daily handwriting lessons where they will learn the correct formation for each individual letter. Once the children are consistently printing most letters, they will move onto pre-cursive handwriting practice.

## Reading:

The children will continue to learn to read through daily RWi phonics lessons. All children will come home with a **RWi 'Book Bag' book** that is matched to the sounds they are learning in school. Please can these be read daily with the children.

Children can change their books when they have read them through with an adult at home twice. Once the home contact book has been signed by a grown up to say the book has been read twice, they can pop it into the book box for changing.

**Music** - The children will have bi weekly music lessons and singing assemblies with Mrs Mencarini. They will be focussing on timbre and rhythmic patterns (Theme: fairy tales)

**PE** - will be on alternate Tuesday. Please can you ensure your child comes to school in a PE kit.
