

## PSHE -

This half term will focus on Economic wellbeing - Money. They will be learning about financial literacy including how adults get money, wants and needs, using skills and talents and inclusive environments.



## RE -

The children will be learning about what it means to be muslim and what influences their beliefs and actions.



## Art:

We will be looking at the work of Rachel Whiteread and using this information to design and make a tile in the style of her sculptures.

The children will be using using the skills they have learned and apply these to create their clay tile houses.



**Maths** - We will be using the Power Maths scheme of work to teach the children about multiplication and division.



**Science** - Children will learn about the methods scientists use to build scientific knowledge about the natural world. They will learn that scientists learn about plants by making careful observations and measurements, recording changes over time and carrying out enquiries to compare the effect of changing conditions. They will develop an understanding of the following types of enquiry: observing over time, pattern seeking, identifying and classifying, comparative testing.



## History -

They will learn that during WW1 many types of animal were used to help the soldiers. They also will learn that children were kept sheltered away from the war and didn't know exactly what was going on. One way children did know about what was happening in the war was through cinema. They would go and watch films that told them about events in the war. They will also investigate that codes were created to stop the enemy finding out what soldiers were planning.

## English -

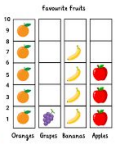
Our first text the children will use is Little Red Riding Hood. Within this unit they will learn the narrative and rewrite the story changing some key details.



Our second text will be exploring poetry and the children will be creating Kenning poems about animals.



**Computing** - Children will explore how to collect information and date through the use of tally counting and pictograms.
