Year 4 - Autumn

SCIENCE

Science: This half term in Year 4 we will be learning all about changes of state. We will be looking at solids, liquids and gases and how they change from one state to another. We will finish off the unit by learning all about the water cycle, including precipitation, condensation and evaporation.

D&T: We will be looking at basic cooking skills by making biscuits, and then adapting our recipes, based on brand testing and market research. We will send a list out for cooking donations nearer the time.

The children will be taught **French** fortnightly. This half term we will be learning how to describe people.

You can keep in touch through Seesaw. We will be sharing our learning with you at home and will send messages about things that are happening in class. Maths - We will be using the Power Maths scheme of work to teach the children about place value. Children will also be learning all of their timetables using a range of class learning and TT Rockstars. Please check My Maths weekly for online maths homework. In Year 4 children take the Multiplication Tables Check. We ask that all children practice on TT Rockstars each evening for ten minutes. All passwords are in the front of home school books.
